#### That's why everyone should know how to change a tire. Just follow these simple steps.

(Instrukcja wymiany koła)

- 1 Take out the spare, the lug wrench, and the jack.
- 2 Set the parking break and, if possible, block the other tires.
- 3 Remove the hubcap, if one is present.
- 4 Loosen the lug nuts. (Note: Do not remove them.)
- 5 Crank the jack to jack up the car enough to remove the tire.
- 6 Remove the lug nuts.
- 7 Pull the wheel off the lug bolts.
- 8 Put on the spare.
- 9 Replace the lug nuts on the lug bolts and tighten them slightly.
- 10 Lower the car.
- 11 Tighten the lug nuts completely.
